ABOVE NORMAL SURFAND VERY STRONG RIP CURRENTS TO CONTINUE
OVER THE LABOR DAY WEEKEND

A LONG PERIOD SOUTHWEST SWELL WILL PRODUCE HIGH SURFTHROUGH FRIDAY AFTERNOON. WIDESPREAD WAVES OF 7 TO 9 FEET ARE EXPECTED ON SOUTHWEST FACING BEACHES, WITH OCCASIONAL SETS TO 11 FEET. WAVES ELSEWHERE WILL RANGE FROM 4 TO 7 FEET. A REINFORCING SOUTH SWELL ARRIVING SATRUDAY WILL KEEP ABOVE AVERAGE SURFTHROUGH THE LABOR DAY WEEKEND. THE HIGH SURF WILL PRODUCE VERY STRONG AND DANGEROUS RIP CURRENTS.

AROUND THE TIMES OF HIGHTID, EXPECT BREAKING WAVES OVER JETTIES.

AROUND THE TIMES OF LOW TIDE, EXPECT HAZARDOUS NAVIGATION

THROUGH THE HARBOR ENTRANCE AT DANA POINT.

NEARBY HARBORS, NEWPORT HARBOR AND OCEANSIDE HARBOR ARE ALSO AFFECTED.
