





Weather Advisory March 15, 2012

Stormy Weather Watch Friday Evening Through Monday

The National Weather Service has issued an advisory for hazardous weather in the Coastal Orange County area.

A strong cold Pacific Storm system is expected to move slowly inland through Southern California. Inclement weather including potential waterspouts over the coastal waters could create challenging boating conditions and the storm could make local driving difficult. Everyone should use extra caution.

This is a good time for boaters to get ready for the storm, including making sure covers are in place, roller-furling headsails are secure, that the vessel's scuppers are clear, and the bilge pumps operational.
