


ORANGE COUNTY AMABULANCE RULES AND REGULATIONS Section 400: Ground Ambulance Service License



ARTICLE IV. LICENSES: GROUND AMBULANCE Section 400: Ground Ambulance Service License

INITIAL LICENSE APPLICATION: I.

To receive a ground ambulance service license the applicant shall:

- A. Complete a Department approved application form.
- B. Provide a criminal background check through the Department of Justice or assure that each principal of the applicant service undergoes a criminal records background check conducted by the Orange County Sheriff-Coroner.
- C. Pass the OCEMS Agency inspection of ambulance service operations including all vehicles to be licensed.
- D. Pay any fees set by the Board of Supervisors.
- E. Meet all requirements identified in the Ordinance.
- F. Comply with all rules and regulations.

II. CONDITIONS OF AMBULANCE SERVICE LICENSES:

- Α. An ambulance service license is valid from the date of issue until December 31 of the same calendar year.
- B. An ambulance service license is nontransferable.
- C. A licensee may make a request to the Medical Director to amend a license. The process for amendment shall be made in the same manner as an initial application.
- The Medical Director may suspend, revoke a license, or place on probation a license holder D. pursuant to the Ordinance for failure to comply and maintain compliance with, or for violation of any applicable provisions, standards, or requirements of State law or the County of Orange Ordinance 3517 or any Agency rule and regulation.

III. LICENSE RENEWALS:

License renewals shall be made in the same manner as an initial application except for the requirement for criminal record background check.
