## ARTICLE V. RECORDKEEPING AND FEES: GROUND AMBULANCE

Section 500: Ground Ambulance: Basic Life Support Medical Record

- I. Attendants shall complete a Department approved Basic Life Support Medical Record for an emergency transport each time:
  - A. An ambulance responds to a request for emergency transport and a fire department paramedic is not present.
  - B. Patient care is relinquished to the ambulance personnel by a paramedic, or a physician at the scene or public safety personnel for an emergency transport.
  - C. A critical patient is transported and a paramedic does not accompany the patient.
- II. One (1) copy of the required Basic Life Support Medical Record shall be sent to the Department on the 1st day of the month following the incident; one (1) copy shall be given to the receiving facility medical staff when delivering the patient, and one (1) copy shall be retained by the provider for seven (7) years.
