ARTICLE VII. LICENSES: AIR TRANSPORT

Section 704: Air Ambulance: Attendant License

REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE: I.

To receive an air ambulance attendant license, an individual shall:

- 1. Complete an OCEMS approved application for air ambulance attendant.
- 2. Show proof of current and valid certification as an EMT-P.
- 3. Pay the applicable licensure fee.
- 4. Obtain a license card from the Orange County Emergency Medical Service.
- II. All air ambulance attendants shall be required to possess a current and valid Orange County Air Ambulance Attendant License whenever performing as a helicopter attendant.

III. CONDITIONS OF AIR AMBULANCE ATTENDANT LICENSES:

- A. The Air Ambulance Attendant License shall expire two (2) years from the date of issuance or sooner if requested by applicant.
- B. An Air Ambulance Attendant License is non-transferable.
- C. A renewal application shall be made in the same manner as that of an initial application.
