

Frequently Asked Questions POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SERVICES

Who does the program serve?

The program serves families with children (Kindergarten through 5th grade) who have challenges in compliance, productivity, and interpersonal relationships due to Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder and Autism Spectrum Disorders. The program targets low-income families within Orange County, providing them with funding support.

What does the program offer?

The program offers a unique school-based, regular public education experience in addition to clinical intervention services.

Where is the program located?

The University of California, Irvine (UCI) School & Education Intervention Program (EIP) is located in Irvine, California, and runs Monday through Friday from 8:30am to 2:30 p.m.

How long do children typically remain in the program?

Children typically remain in the program between 1 ½ to 2 years. The program mission is to provide intervention for problem behavior, prevent placement in a more restrictive environment, and return the children to a less restrictive school setting as quickly as is appropriate.
