High Surf Advisory in Effect

Beginning Friday

through Monday

The National Weather Service has issued an advisory for high surf in the Coastal Orange County area.

9 to 10 feet waves with high surf is expected Saturday evening, then subsiding on Monday.

High surf expected to affect beaches in the advisory areas producing rip currents and localized beach erosion. Entrance to harbors will be very dangerous due to breaking waves, everyone should use extra caution.
