



## PET LICENSE APPLICATION

In Orange County, all dogs over the age of four (4) months are required by law to be licensed and vaccinated against rabies. Residents owning or having custody of any dog must license the dog within 15 days of acquisition or within 15 days after the license becomes due (Anaheim residents have 30 days). Residents must provide proof of a California approved rabies vaccination to obtain a license (OCCO 4-1-70). Failure to comply with the above time frames will result in a late fee of \$35.00 and possible referral to a collections unit. For accounts that are sent to collections, an additional non-compliance fee of \$30.00 will be added, a court judgment may be filed against you and credit reporting agencies may be notified.

- → Rabies Vaccination Certificate (Note: Veterinary receipts for vaccination will not be accepted as proof of vaccination and will delay the license application process)
- → Proof of age for the Senior Citizen's Discount (if applicable)

Or, you may apply in person or over the phone to obtain your pet's license tag, 7 days a week, 8:00AM - 5:00PM, Wednesday 8:00AM - 7:00PM (Excluding Holidays).
