May be eligible for discounts (Federal subsidies) or insurance coverage at no cost (through Medi-Cal) based on income and family size. Do not qualify for Medi-Cal, CCS or other health insurance and no insurance available through parent's employer.  Citizenship/immigration status is not required. <b>B E N E F I T S</b>	All plans include the "Essential health benefits": doctor visits, hospital stays, emergency care, maternity care, children's care, prescriptions, medical tests and mental health care.  Families can choose their plan and coverage.	Recipients may become members of CalOptima as this is the managed care in Orange County.  "Essential health benefits": doctor visits, hospital stays, emergency care, maternity care, children's care, prescriptions, medical tests and mental health care. Dental and Vision if eligible.	Medical visits for treatment and preventive services, specialty care, emergency room, hospitalization, mental health, prescription drugs, applicable lab and x-rays, some dental and vision care.
