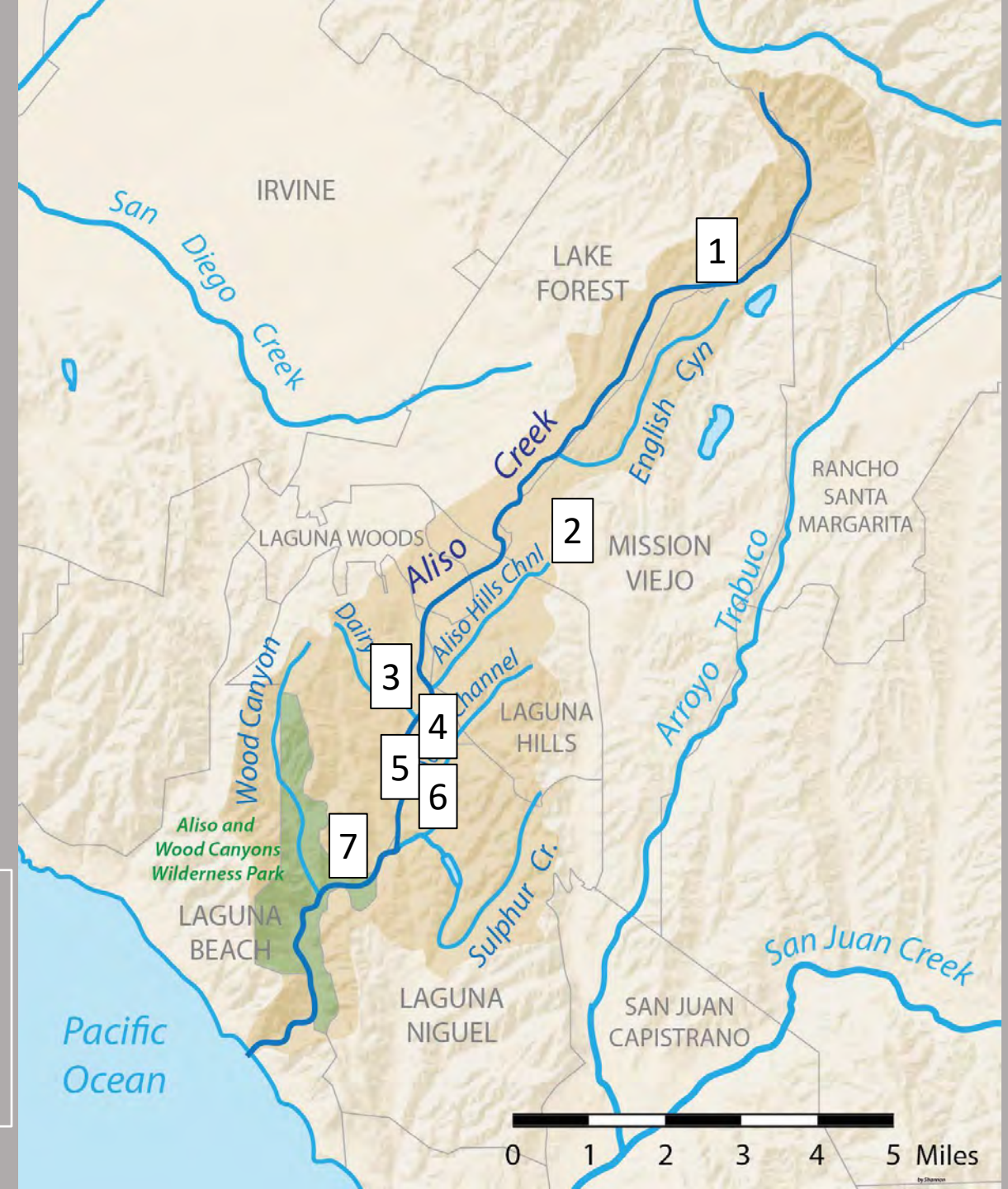

# Aliso Creek Watershed

1. County of Orange Invasive Removal \$700,000
  2. Conservation Corps Invasive Removal \$500,000
  3. Dairy Fork Urban Runoff Wetlands \$875,000
  4. Pecten Reef SCC \$677,400
  5. OCTA Measure M Project \$1,850,000
  6. WCB Aliso Creek \$709,000
  7. Prop 50 Invasive Control Project \$1,100,000
- ❖ Warne Family Fund Grant Program \$275,000

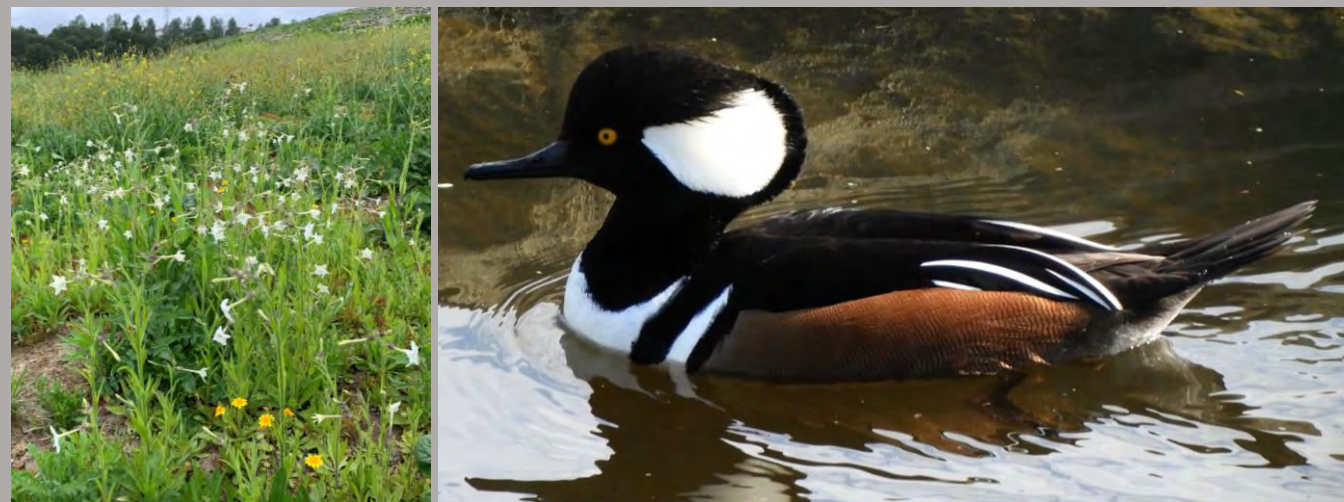
A total of \$6.7 million dollars in funding including roughly \$2 million dollars within the last 4 years





# Accomplishments

- Create native habitat and increase biodiversity
- Improve ecosystems services and functions
- Protect sensitive paleo resources
- Increase community knowledge about the Aliso Creek
- Collect scientific data on the presence/absence of sensitive wildlife species
- Develop and strengthen key partnerships to facilitate collaborative planning and management

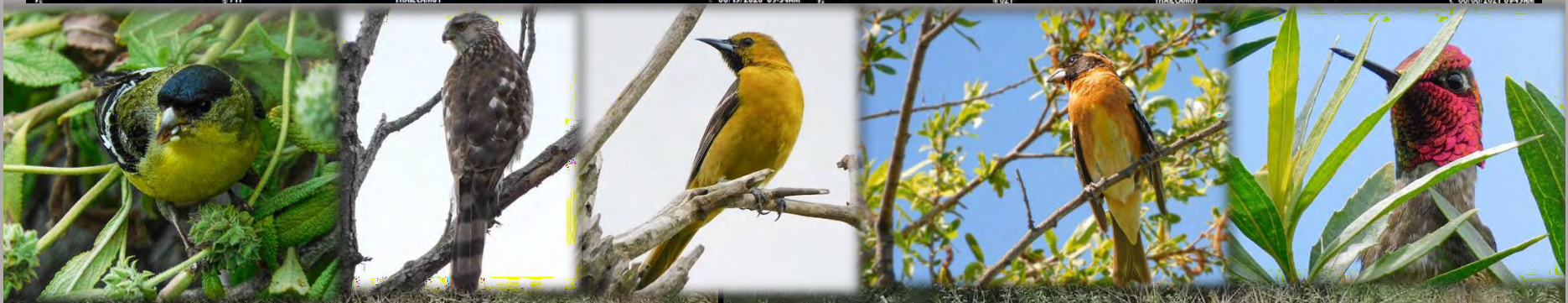
