Here the public can learn about Madame Helena Modjeska, famous Shakespearean actress in the late 1800's, and the historical significance of the home and gardens she so fondly called the "Forest of Arden." The site is currently undergoing a restoration project for one of the historic structures. This tour offers a behind the scenes look at the restoration work in progress and will discuss the history of Arden and its structures.

Katie McKay, OC Parks Historic Curator, presented the history of Arden and explained its historical significance, led the tour of Arden, and answered the Commissioners' questions.

Dennis Shaffer, OC Parks Operations Manager, answered the Commissioners' questions.

Dave Bunk, KC Restoration Carpenter, provided an update on the restoration of the Joseph Pleasants Stone Building and answered the Commissioners' questions.
