PROJECT OVERVIEW

Moulton Niguel Water District will replace nearly two miles of sewer pipeline within Laguna Niguel Regional Park. The existing pipelines carry wastewater from Moulton Niguel's pump station to the Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant.

A \$10.3 million grant will fund up to 75% of the project. This grant is administered by the California Office of Emergency Services and funded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

The new pipelines will help to ensure continued safe and reliable service for our community.

Enhanced Capacity: The new force mains will convey over half of all the wastewater generated in MNWD's service area, ensuring efficient wastewater management.
