#### Summary

Archery Range volunteers provide support for safe archery range operation. The range in is located at Mile Square Regional Park in Fountain Valley, CA.

## **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Ensure archers follow posted safety rules.
- Intervene when unsafe conditions exist.
- Provide technical assistance to archers.
- Assist park staff during public beginning archery classes.
- Develop beginning archery competitions for the public.

## **Eligibility**

- Complete all requirements as an OC Parks Volunteer.
- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Obtain Mile Square Regional Park staff approval.
- Ability to obtain USA Archery Level I Instructor certification.

# **Training Path**

- 1. Complete OC Parks Volunteer training program.
  - a. Program Orientation Training
  - b. Background check
  - c. CPR and First Aid Certification
  - d. Complete site-specific training to receive park certification.
  - e. Receive OC Parks Volunteer uniform.
- 2. Complete USA Archery Level I Instructor certification. (Only if planning to teach archery lessons. Is not a requirement for all Archery Range Volunteers.)

#### **Typical Schedule**

- Saturdays and Sundays during Archery Range operating hours.
- Assist with tournaments and special events.
