

#### **Summary**

Provide park visitors with information, assistance and services in campground facilities when no park staff is present. Camp Hosts are provided a campsite and utility services (when available) at no charge.

# **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Provide general information, directions and check-in instructions.
- Sell firewood.
- Conduct routine campground checks.
- Perform light maintenance tasks.
- Report any emergencies and direct responding agencies.
- Resolve after-hours disturbances

# Eligibility

- Complete all requirements as an OC Parks Volunteer
- 18 years of age
- Physically capable of performing Camp Host services.
- Have a valid driver's license for duration of service.
- Have vehicle insurance as required by County for duration of service.
- Provide RV that is functioning and in good repair.
- Be available on-call 24 hours per day, 7 days per week when scheduled.
- Complete Camphost application.
- Obtain park staff approval.

#### **Training Path**

- 1. Complete OC Parks Volunteer training program.
  - a. Program Orientation Training
  - b. Background check
  - c. CPR and First Aid Certification
  - d. Complete site-specific training to receive park certification.
  - e. Receive OC Parks Volunteer uniform.
- 2. Complete Camp Host Training Sheet with park rangers.

### **Typical Schedule**

 20 hours per week, especially Saturdays and Sundays evenings during peak camping activity.
